

Transport in the UK (without a car)

Transport to the Hotels - If you require transport from the airport, train station or coach station we can provide you with details of taxi companies that can take you to the hotel. The fare will be payable to the taxi driver at the time but sometimes we can co-ordinate your journey so that we can group people together, where possible, providing you advise us of your expected arrival times to enable it to be as cost effective as possible for you.

Transport to Painting Locations - When painting on location, we will be able to take some people in either the tutor’s car or one of our cars. If you do not have transport or do not drive then we will do our best to find a space for you in one of our cars.

Foreign Travellers in the UK

Bristol Airport - Travellers arriving from around Europe or further afield are best to arrive at **Bristol Airport** as this is fairly near to most locations, not far from the train station taking you to these locations and the airport has the highest number of international flights.

If arriving at **Bristol Airport** then **Bristol Temple Meads Train station** is only a 25 minute taxi journey from there. There are frequent buses and coaches to Bristol Temple Meads and other locations. Exact details can be found on the Bristol Airport website (www.bristolairport.co.uk)

Also, please note that the **Swan Hotel, Wells** is only a 30 minute taxi journey from **Bristol Airport**

Exeter Airport - Travellers arriving from some locations in Europe can arrive at **Exeter Airport**. If you are able to fly to here it is easier for **Dartmoor, Exmoor and Cornwall**.

Exeter St David’s Train Station is a 30 minute taxi journey from **Exeter Airport** where you can get a train to **Barnstaple/Tiverton** for **Exmoor** OR **Falmouth/Penzance** for **The Lizard Peninsula, Cornwall**.

If travelling to **Dartmoor** then you can get a taxi direct to the hotel from **Exeter Airport** which is also only 30 minutes away.

Newquay Airport is predominantly a domestic airport and is only worth flying to if flying into **Heathrow/Gatwick** from outside the UK or for those living further north in England, Scotland and Ireland. It is then an hour and half taxi journey to the hotel.

Heathrow/Gatwick - For long haul travellers it is likely that you will be best to arrive at **Heathrow** or **Gatwick Airport** and if your onward journey is by train then you need to get the underground to **Paddington** from **Heathrow** and if it is **Gatwick** you can get a train to **Heathrow** first. However, on the London Underground there are different ways of arriving at the same destination so look into the most efficient at the time.

Please Note

- The **Swan Hotel, Wells** is only a 30 minute taxi journey from **Bristol Airport**.
- **Leigh Park Hotel** is about an hour taxi journey from **Bristol Airport**
- **Leigh Park Hotel** is a two hour taxi journey from **Heathrow & Gatwick**
- **Leigh Park Hotel** - You can get a bus from **Bath** to **Bradford-on-Avon**
- **Bells Hotel** is just over an hour from **Bristol Airport**
- **Cwrt Bleddyn Hotel** is about an hour from **Bristol Airport**
- **Nant Ddu Lodge** is just over an hour and a half from **Bristol Airport**
- **Nant Ddu Lodge** is about an hour from **Cardiff Airport**
- **Dartmoor Lodge** is just over an hour and a half from **Bristol Airport**
- **Dartmoor Lodge** is about 30 minutes from **Exeter Airport**
- **Simonsbath House Hotel - Tiverton** will be a more expensive taxi journey than **Barnstaple** but **Tiverton** is a short journey by train by around 2 hours if coming from Bristol. If coming from the west it is probably still an hour longer via Barnstaple
- **Lee Wood Hotel** is about 45 minutes taxi journey from **Manchester Airport**
- It is always advisable to book a taxi in advance but for some stations it is essential
- We cannot be sure of pricing but if you work on a minimum charge of £10-£20 and for journeys less than 30 minutes it is around £1 per mile and for those beyond 30 minutes it is £1.50 per mile.
